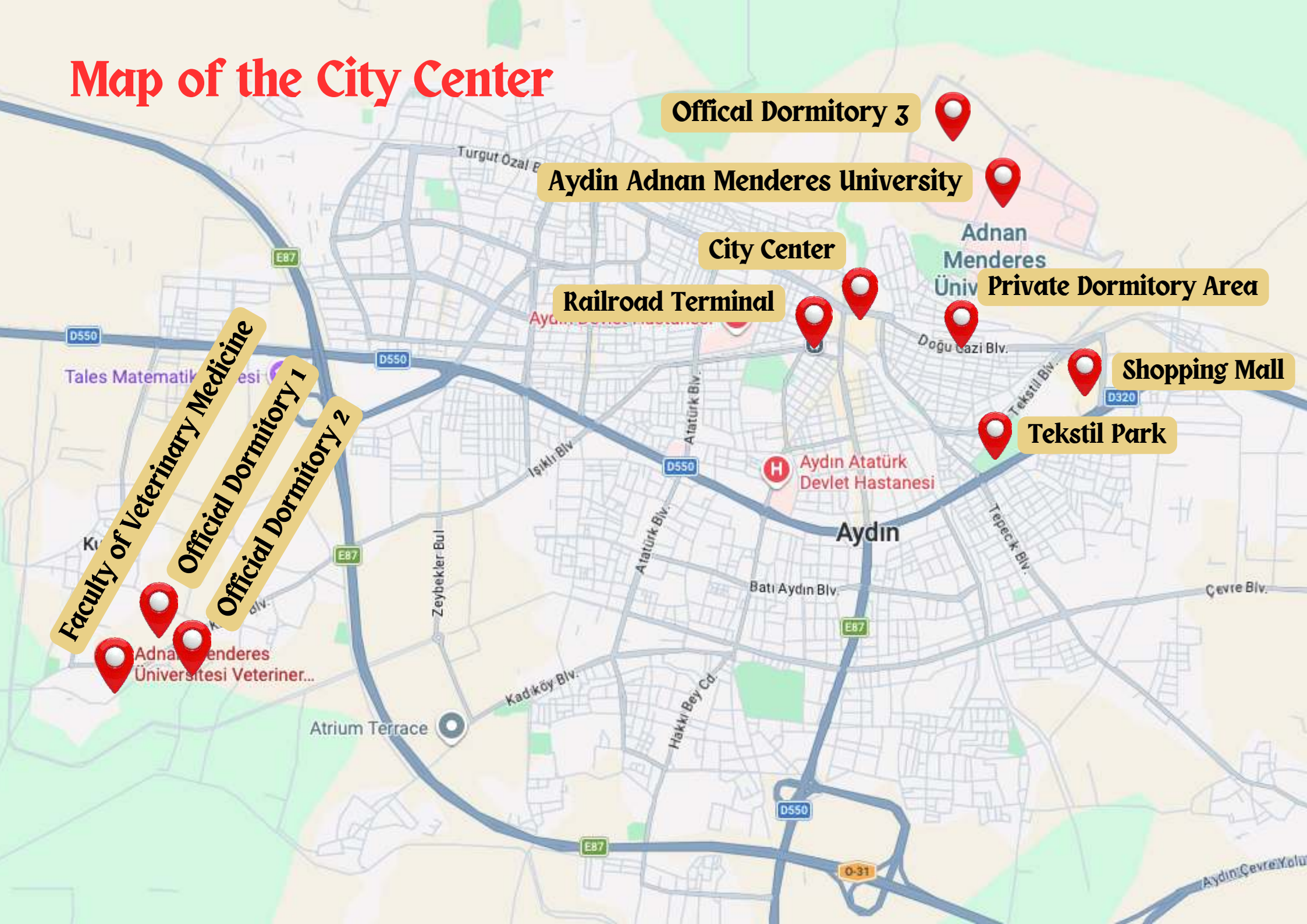


Welcome to Aydın!

The nearest airport to Aydın is İzmir Adnan Menderes Airport, located about 90 km away. From the airport, you can reach Aydın city center by Havaş shuttle or train. Train tickets can be bought through the E-Bilet app.

To reach the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, you can take bus 103, 11, or the Işıklı minibus from the city center. Bus 103 accepts credit cards, the other options require cash. You can use the Moovit or Ayulaş apps to check the bus times.

Accommodation

- **Dormitory Options:** Public and private dormitories are available for students.
- **Public Dormitories:** Located in Işıklı near the Veterinary Faculty and on the main campus in the center and cost around 20 Euros per month.
- **Private Dormitories:** Generally located in the city center and cost around 200–500 Euros per month.
- **Room Options:** Public dormitories usually have 4 students per room, private dormitories offer single or shared rooms.



Student Life in Aydın

Aydın offers a comfortable and social lifestyle for students. In the city center, especially around Sevgi Yolu Street and Doğu Gazi Boulevard, there are many shops, cafés, restaurants, bars, and pubs. Students usually spend their time in these areas.

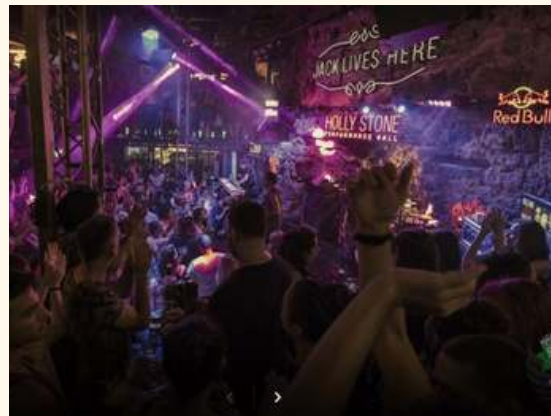
There are two shopping malls: Forum Aydın Mall and OPS Mall. In these malls, you can shop, go to the cinema, and enjoy different restaurants.



Student Life in Aydın

Located in the center, Tekstil Park is an important social and cultural area for students. Inside the park, there are sports facilities, cafes, librarys, and an exhibition area. Cultural activities such as open-air cinemas and concerts are also organized here.

Sometimes students also go to parties organized by faculty student clubs, giving them a chance to socialize and take a break from their studies.

Very close to the city, Kuşadası is a popular tourist destination. It offers many restaurants, bars, cafés, and pubs, as well as beautiful beaches and natural areas such as National Park, making it a great place for both entertainment and nature.

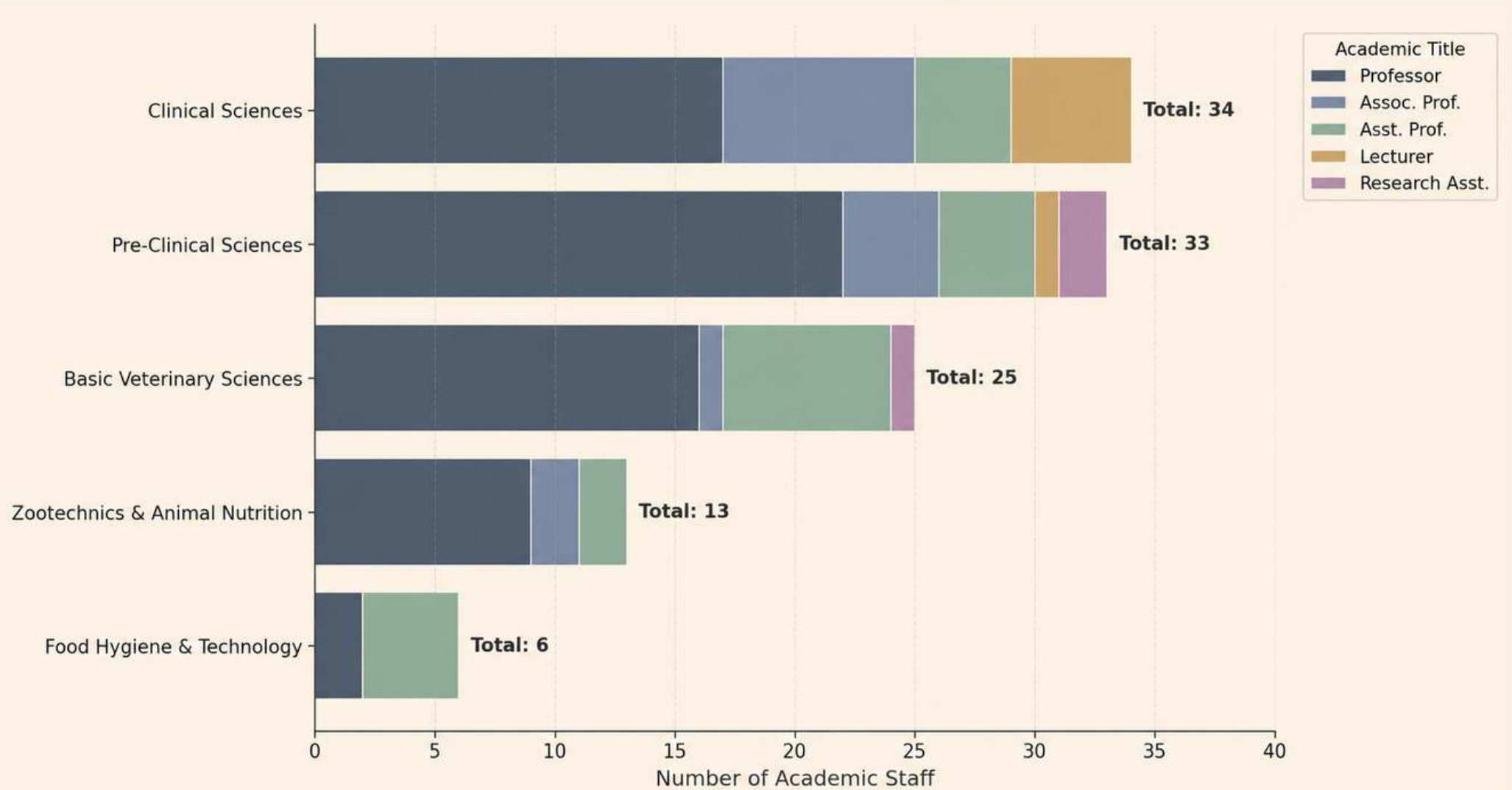

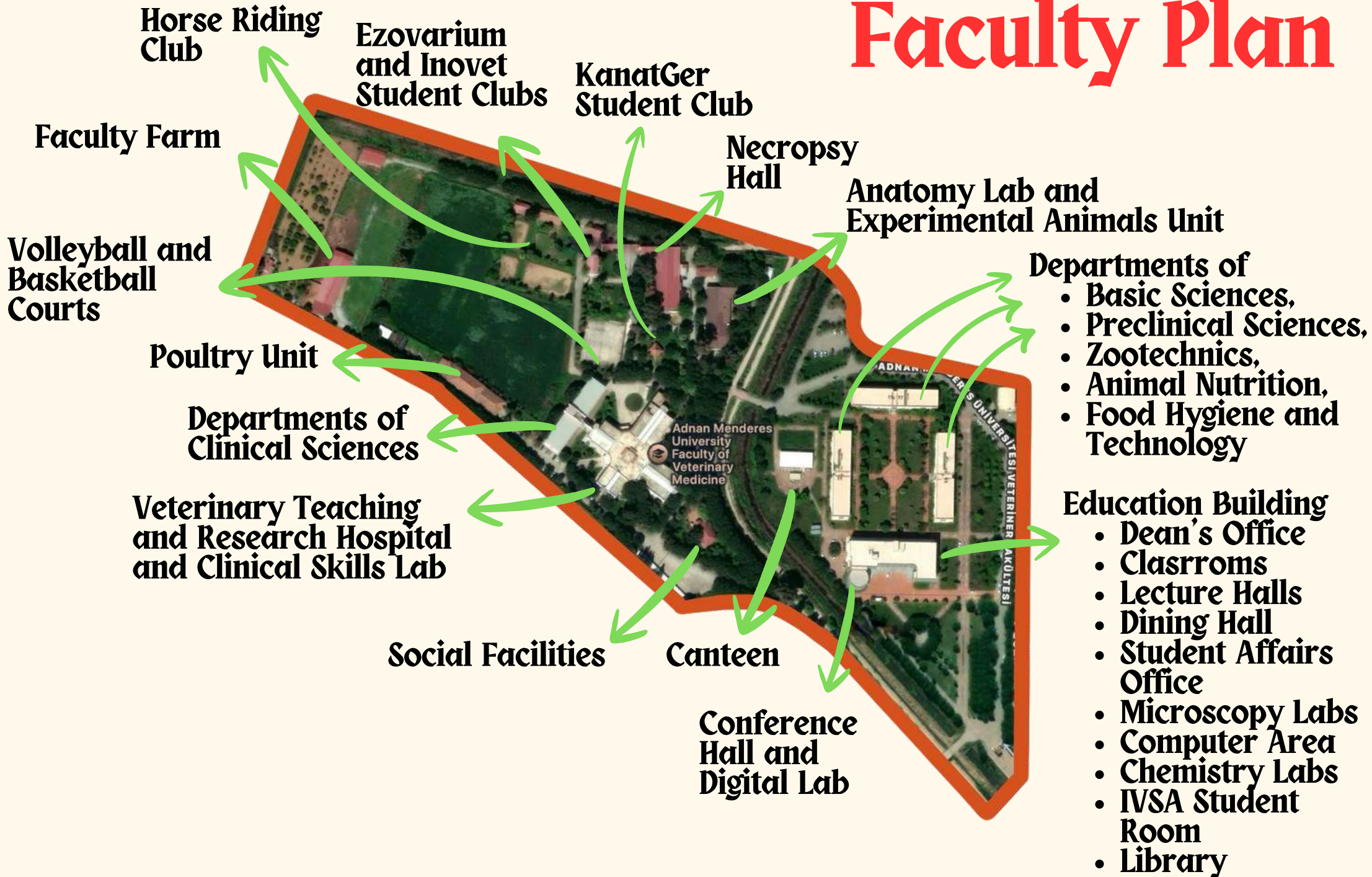

Physical Conditions

The faculty operates in 11 blocks on the campus. There are lecture halls, library, computer area, microscope laboratories, chemistry laboratories, anatomy laboratories, necropsy room, clinical skills laboratory, veterinary teaching and research hospital, teaching farm, poultry-house, experimental animals unit, and dairy product manufacturing unit as well as social areas like student clubs areas, cafeteria and meeting rooms.



Faculty Plan



Veterinary Teaching and Research Hospital

Two separate entrances are made for companion animals and farm animals. There are examination rooms particularly separate for cats and dogs. A field is prepared privately for farm animals where they can be examined, operated, or hospitalized. The hospital has operating theaters, a preparation room, and a sterilization room. The hospital provides 24/7 emergency clinic services. there Also the hospital, through the mobile clinic vehicle, along with students, conducts Mobile Clinic Operations, involving academic personnel from various branches. More than 10.000 patiens come to our hospital annually.



Clinical Skills Laboratory

The Clinical Skills Laboratory, established within the faculty hospital to improve veterinary students' clinical competencies, provides students with the opportunity to practice professional procedures in a safe and controlled environment. In this laboratory, students can gain hands-on experience in examination techniques, injection practices, basic surgical skills, patient handling, and the use of clinical equipment. The Clinical Skills Laboratory helps students build confidence, transform theoretical knowledge into practice, and become better prepared for clinical life.



Teaching Farm and Poultry Unit



The Teaching Farm of our faculty includes cattle, sheep-goat, and pig units, providing students with hands-on training opportunities. Here, veterinary students can develop their clinical skills, practice animal handling and examination techniques, and gain practical experience in animal health and herd management. The farm helps students apply their theoretical knowledge in a real-life setting and prepares them for professional practice.

Digital Lab

It enables students to improve their technical and analytical skills by using modern software, simulations, and digital learning tools.



Experimental Animals Unit

The experimental animal unit within the faculty provides live laboratory animals to faculties and institutes conducting research in the field of health sciences.



Library and Computerized Library

The traditional library provides a quiet environment where students can access essential textbooks and academic resources. The computerized library supports students in research and evidence-based learning by offering access to digital databases, journals, and online resources.

The Horse Riding Club was established in 2003 within the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine at ADU and is one of the university's oldest, largest, and most active student clubs. Egzovarium

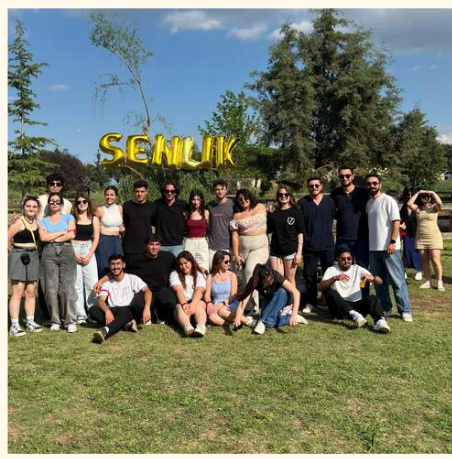

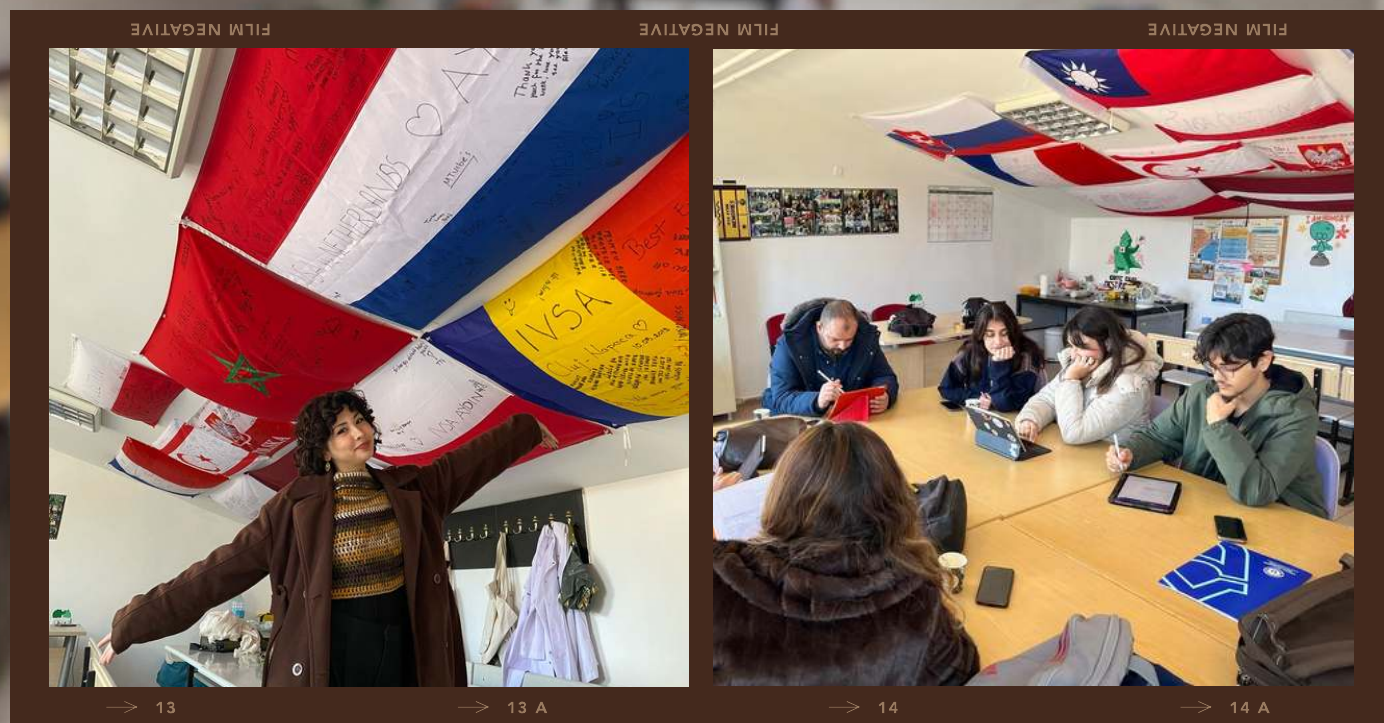
